The John Edsall/John Wood Asthma Center is dedicated to providing comprehensive care and education for patients with asthma and allergy. The Asthma Center, staffed by Board Certified pulmonologists and allergists, a Clinical Nurse Specialist, Asthma Educators, and Social Workers provide unique outpatient care for individuals with asthma and support several educational and outreach programs in the community. Pulmonary function testing, bronchoprovocation testing, allergy testing and immunotherapy are available. Screening for other diseases that are often associated with asthma, such as sinusitis, rhinitis, nasal polyps and gastrointestinal reflux are performed on site. In addition, Asthma Center staff reviews each individual's home and work environment to determine which indoor and outdoor allergens might be
